JUDGING EXTRAVAGANZA IS PART OF 4-H DAY

New in 2025, we are expanding the judging contests that are part of 4-H Day into a Judging Extravaganza! Judging Extravaganza is a come-and-go experience. There is no pre-registration required for these contests. Youth will participate individually, yet an optional team competition of four members will be available. Study guides for each judging contest is available at www.postrock.k-state.edu/4-h/events/judging-extravaganza/. Judging Extravaganza is a great district-level activity for your achievement pin applications. The contests have been strategically planned to also compliment your project records. As an example, a life skills contest benefits all youth and can be specifically noted on any project record. An animal science related contest can be noted on any livestock or pet record. Be sure to ask your 4-H Program Coordinator for tips about listing these experiences on your project record reports!

MODEL MEETING SUBMISSION AT 4-H DAY

Model meetings will not be performed at 4-H Day. They will be recorded by video with audio and submitted virtually. The meeting agenda and secretary's notes must be submitted along with the recorded meeting. Submit before or on the day of 4-H Day #2. It will be judged as soon as possible following 4-H Day #2 and results shared with the club once available. The Outstanding Presentation Sensation (OPS) will be selected from all district-wide entries. Plan ahead now to get your model meeting completed.

Participants need to sign-up in advance. To do so, members need to log into their YQCA account, go to "enrolled training", and select the course labeled "Beloit 4-H Day Training". Members will be able to enroll and pay for the course online. Participants also need to take a pre-test online before attending the inperson training! YQCA is a livestock quality assurance program that covers food safety, animal well-being, and character development. It is a great learning experience for youth involved in any livestock project! K-STATE JUNIOR PRODUCER DAYS

LIVESTOCK TAGGING AND ANIMAL WEIGH-INS

Each county hosts a beef weigh-in and a small animal weigh-in. The dates will be shared on your county's newsletter page. Attending the weigh-in is required to participate in the rate-of-gain contest at your county fair. It is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED to bring your animal to the beef and small animal weigh-in events because attending can assure you are understanding of and ready to meet all exhibition requirements (so you won't be disqualified at fair); you can connect with other adults and youth in the project for support, encouragement, and assistance throughout the year; and you can get many of your questions answered.

Post Rock District will not sell Kansas 4-H EID tags over-the-counter at our Extension Offices. The state requires our staff to approve all State Nominations for livestock, and part of that approval process is confirming that we have physically seen each Kansas 4-H EID tag in your livestock animal's ear at tagging time (photos and over-the-counter sales do not qualify). Plan to attend your county's tagging and verification event (i.e. weigh-in) for beef, swine, sheep and goats. Call the Extension Office ASAP if you know you'll have a conflict and need an animal State 4-H tagged.
