Kansas Energy Program

Provides energy education to Kansas agricultural producers and small businesses and helps those entities submit federal grant applications through the USDA Rural Energy for America Program to receive reimbursement for energy efficiency and renewable energy projects, all at no cost.

KEP also conducts energy education activities, such as the Kansas KidWind Challenge and K-12 Energy Benchmarking Project, to K-12 schools in Kansas.

Pollution Prevention Institute

Protects public health and promotes sustainability through environmental education and services to industry, institutions, and communities.

The Small Business Environmental Assistance Program helps Kansas small businesses comply with environmental regulations and identify pollution prevention opportunities.

Kansas Radon Program

Provides expert technical assistance, public education and point source reduction related to indoor radon gas exposure, the leading risk factor for lung cancer for non-smokers in the U.S.

KRP provides radon kits, year-long technical assistance, and in-person educational opportunities for industry stakeholders.
